On March 9, 1997, LAPD Wilshire Area Homicide Detectives responded to Fairfax Avenue and Wilshire Boulevard to investigate the shooting death of celebrity "rap" entertainer Christopher Wallace, AKA: "Notorious Big-E", DOB: 5-21-72. Detective K. Cooper #23682 conducted the crime scene investigation, interviewed witnesses and recovered evidence which revealed that Wallace died at the hands of another (Refer to LAPD Preliminary Investigation Report DR# 97-0711963 attached hereto as exhibit #1). During the crime scene investigation, Seven 9 millimeter ammunition cartridge casings were collected and booked as evidence along with two ballistic projectiles recovered from the victim (Refer to Los Angeles Police Department Property Report,

DR #97-0711963, and attached hereto as Exhibit #2).

The initial investigation revealed that prior to the murder, Wallace was attending an awards party at the Peterson Museum, 6060 Wilshire Boulevard, Los Angeles, following the Soul Train Awards Ceremony. It was learned that the victim exited the party and departed the location at approximately 0045 hours in a vehicle, a 1997 Chevrolet Suburban (California License #3TPK180). That vehicle was part of a three car motorcade. The motorcade proceeded north on Fairfax Avenue. While stopped at the red phase signal light at the intersection at Fairfax Avenue and Wilshire Boulevard, a lone male suspect maneuvered his vehicle beside the victim's vehicle and fired multiple gunshots at the victim. The suspect accelerated his vehicle north on Fairfax Avenue, then east on Wilshire Boulevard.

Detectives interviewed four eye witnesses (Kenneth Story, Reginald Blaylock, Gregory Young, and James Lloyd), who described the suspect as a male, Black, light complexion, short hair, and wearing a bow tie. Witnesses Young and Lloyd both describe the vehicle as only dark or grey in color. Witnesses Story and Blaylock were more specific of their description of the suspect's vehicle. They both describe it as a new model Chevrolet Impala Super Sport, black in color. (Refer to Witness Statements attached hereto as Exhibit #3).

On March 11, 1997, at approximately 1745 hours, Detective G. Escontrias #24189 received a telephone call from an anonymous female caller who identified the killer of "Big-E" (moniker for Christopher Wallace) as Dwayne Davis from Compton. A follow-up investigation regarding this information revealed the identity of Duane Keith Davis, DOB: 6-14-63, also known as "Keefy-D", a member of the South Side Compton Crip Gang, and resides at 1405 South Burris Street, Compton.

(Refer to computer print records of the Department of Motor Vehicles and of the California State Parole, attached hereto as Exhibit #4).

On March 20, 1997, Detective J. Edwards #24325 interviewed witness James Lloyd, an associate and friend to the victim. Lloyd was present at the scene of the murder and had accompanied Wallace to the awards party at the Peterson Museum. Lloyd positively identified Duane Keith Davis from a six-person photo lineup display card as the individual that approached him, while at the awards party. told him he was the man to see for security while in Los Angeles.

On April 2, 1997, Robbery-Homicide Division assumed the investigative responsibility, and I was assigned to the task force headed by Detectives F. Miller #15781 and R. Poole #23068.

A query of the Los Angeles Police Department Automated Information Systems revealed that on March 8, 1996, Duane Keith Davis, was issued a traffic citation by the California Highway Patrol for violations occurring near the 91 and 110 freeways. Davis was driving a 1996 Chevrolet Impala, black, Vehicle Identification Number 1G1B152P3TR106720. (Refer to photo copy of California Highway Patrol traffic citation #CL54966, attached hereto as Exhibit #5). A query of the Department of Motor records revealed that this vehicle is registered to Patrick Arneal Parker, 1405 South Kornblum Avenue, Hawthorne, 90250 and assigned California License Plate 3NMR071 (Refer to Department of Motor Vehicles computer print record attached hereto as Exhibit #6).

A query of Department of Motor Vehicle records revealed that Duane K. Davis had registered a 1996 Suzuki (Off Highway Vehicle) to an address at 1524 South California Street (Refer to Department of Motor Vehicles computer print record attached hereto as Exhibit #7).



Department resources revealed that this address is the home of Paula Johnson, DOB: 8-24-66. Johnson is Duane K, Davis' girlfriend.

On April 18, 1997, and again on May 23, 1997, Detective Poole directed personnel from Air Support Division to surveil the house at 1524 South California Street and determine if the black Chevrolet Impala Super Sport was parked at the location. On both occasions, Officer McGee #23053 from Air Support Division informed Detective Poole that a black Chevrolet Impala Super Sport with chrome wheels was parked in the rear yard at 1524 South California Street. However, due to the position of the vehicle, the license plate number was unreadable.

Based upon the foregoing and upon my experience and expertise as a homicide investigator, it is my opinion that Duane Keith Davis has access to the black Chevrolet Impala Super Sport parked at his girlfriend's house, 1524 South California Street. It is also my belief that there is sufficient cause to believe that this may be the vehicle that was used in the drive-by murder of Christopher Wallace.

Furthermore, it is your affiant's intention to cause the aforementioned vehicle to be removed from the present location and towed to the Los Angeles Police Department storage building so that personnel from the Scientific Investigation Division may examine, detect and collect any and all trace evidence that may exist on or within the vehicle. The Los Angeles Police Department will burden the expense of such removal and storage of said vehicle.

Based upon the aforementioned information and investigation, I hereby request that a search warrant that a search warrant be issued for the seizure of said property, or any part thereof, from said vehicle, at any time of the day, good cause being shown thereof.

I request that this affidavit, search warrant, and supporting attachments be sealed pending further order of the court. I make the request for the following reasons. Without sealing, the affidavit and supporting documentation and warrant become a matter of public record within ten days. I submit that premature disclosure of the information contained in the documents will serve no useful purpose and will unnecessarily place the investigation in jeopardy and will undermine the continuing investigation herein.

In addition, most of the information obtained has been acquired in confidence by officers in the course of their employment and has not been disclosed to the public as yet. We do not wish to divulge the information contained within these documents for fear that the perpetrator(s) will destroy evidence and/or impede our chances for a successful investigation. I believe that disclosure of the information prior to completion of our investigation would be against the public interest because the necessity for preserving the confidentiality of the information outweighs the necessity for Thus, I believe the information contained within the aforementioned documents is entitled to protection provided by the official information privilege pursuant to Evidence Code section 1040 In addition, due to the sensitive nature of the matter and possible privacy invasion of the defendants and/or witnesses herein, I request the court order sealing of the warrant and documents in support thereof pending further order of court.
